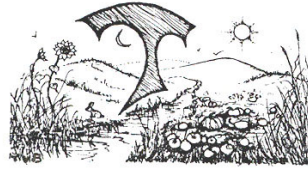


What is Canticle Farm?

Canticle Farm is:

- Community Supported Agriculture [CSA] that uses natural growing practices to provide safe, healthy food without the use of chemicals or pollutants.
- A partnership between the farmer and the consumer to assure quality produce and farm economic stability, where all individuals are treated with dignity and respect.
- A not-for-profit corporation sponsored by the Franciscan Sisters of Allegany [FSA] where Creation-centered spirituality is our focus.
- A community resource for all to learn, enjoy and participate in educational and hands-on projects.
- A contributor to local organizations assisting low income members of our community.
- A commitment to promoting the local economy and reducing pollution to protect the global environment.



Canticle Farm's History

- In 2000, the Franciscan Sisters of Allegany [FSA] voted to support the creation of a Community Supported Agriculture [CSA] farm.
- In 2001, the FSA purchased land on S. Nine Mile Road to begin a local, sustainable farm that works in partnership with the community.
- In 2003, Canticle Farm became a non-profit corporation sponsored by the FSA and recognized by the state of New York.

Canticle Farm's Mission

- to operate an Earth-friendly farm
- to involve people throughout the community
- to do so in a setting of Creation-centered spirituality
- to live the core values of FSA teachings:

Love of God

Love of Creation

Love of the Earth

Love of all people

How does it work?

- You purchase a "share" of the farm harvest. Several types of shares are available. You can also reduce your share cost by contributing "participating hours" of your time or talents – be it office, field or committee work.
- You pick up your harvest share on days and times designated by the farm. If your share is not picked up and prior arrangements have not been made, it will be donated to a local food pantry.
- You share in the rewards and risks of the growing season. Weather and other natural events may influence the quality and abundance of our harvest.

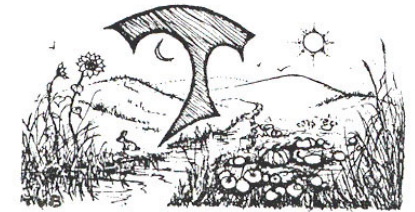
